

Port Visits:

JNPT PORT (Mumbai) -



JNPT, Jawaharlal Port Trust located at Mumbai is the point where India's trade lines converge with the worlds. It is the busiest sea port in India where India's major chunk of export and import takes place. It is the best place for seeing and learning how the actual physical transactions of cargoes and shipping are happening which is an important part of

the operational aspects of International Business.

Therefore, IIBR have made it an objective to inculcate JNPT port visits as a compulsory part of its course curriculum. Every year Institute takes the students of International Business and Logistics specializations for a study cum experiential tour of JNPT port under the guidance of an expert from JNPT. Port visits are organized during Semester I of the course curriculum of PGDM IB, the last JNPT visit took place on 13th Sept 2010. The learning worth mentioning are the actual sight of container ships being loaded with containers with the help of huge cranes, tug boats pushing/towing ships, terminals of containers, GTI, NSICT,

Mormugao Port (Goa)-

As a part of the course curriculum, students of IIBR had visited the Mormugao port trust which is located in Goa. This was the second port visit which the students of 2009 – 2011 batch have undergone, their first been JNPT port on 20th April'10. This visit took place in the month of 20th Nov 2010. The visit was a significant one as Mormugao Port is a port which is worth exploiting since it is one of the oldest port in India where Vasco Da Gama had explored in the past. It was quite an experience to the students seeing and learning the real-time berthing of ships and the unique facilities, equipments and process used in handling bulk liquid and dry cargoes, particularly the iron ores as Goa is the premier iron ore exporting port in India.
